PROJECT SUMMARY

The Goda Beautification Project aimed to transform the Godavari riverfront into a scenic, culturally enriched, community gathering and engagement space.

Beautification project included civil, horticultural, and electric work i.e., Goda garden, Goda walk area, Goda ghat, stone “Deepstambh”, bollards, divider, Tree plantation with 3 years operation and maintenance.

The project involved the development of appealing ghat areas keeping in mind the overall sustainability, aesthetics, and beauty.

This project involved installation of basalt stone flooring, landscaping, walkway/jogging track, children play area, laserfountains, open/green gymnasium, thematic wall structure based on Ramayana theme, amphitheatre, CCTV security surveillance, open air restaurant and all the colourful flower plants to maintain the flora & fauna of the park.

This project has helped in enhancing the natural environment by keeping an ecological balance and historic charm in spite of installing modern functionalities.

- ▶ Multifunctional Walkways: Offering public spaces for leisurely strolls and connectivity along the riverbank.
- ▶ Entertainment Hub: Creation of a vibrant riverfront public area for social gatherings and cultural activities.
- ▶ Ghat Enhancement: Installation of durable basalt stone steps, bollards, and traditional “Deepstambh”, enriching both safety and the visual appeal of the riverfront.
- ▶ Basalt Flooring: Aesthetic and long lasting basalt stone flooring, contributing to the overall heritage look of the space.
- ▶ This Project revitalizes the Goda Riverfront, blending tradition with modern amenities for a more vibrant public space.
